Monday - St. Brigid's Day / The First Day of Spring

English:

- 1. English in Practice: Day 92 & 93
- 2. Writing Recount: Write about 'A Day with my friend'. Write all about a happy day that you spent with your friend. <u>Challenge: Use connectives</u> like: and, but, so, because, until, even though...Connectives join two small sentences together. We use connectives to expand our sentences and make them longer. Remember that we only use 'and' once in a sentence.
