<u>Maths</u>	Recognising coins. Get a 1c, 2c and 5c coin. Show them to the child and discuss them: 1c is smallest, 5c is the biggest etc. Complete Pg. 113 and 114 in big book (Busy at Maths)	Show children multiple 1c, 2c and 5c coins. Practice adding up 1c coins first (up to 5) Demonstrate that a 2c coin is worth 2 1c coins and a 5c is worth 5 1c coins. Complete pg. 115 in big book (Busy at Maths) <u>https://my.cjfallon.ie/dash</u> board/resources	Busy at Maths pg. 30 and 31 (Home Links Book) Make sure child points to the objects when counting.
