<u>Maths</u>	<p>Recognising coins. Get a 1c, 2c and 5c coin. Show them to the child and discuss them: 1c is smallest, 5c is the biggest etc.</p> <p>Complete Pg. 113 and 114 in big book (Busy at Maths)</p>	<p>Show children multiple 1c, 2c and 5c coins. Practice adding up 1c coins first (up to 5)</p> <p>Demonstrate that a 2c coin is worth 2 1c coins and a 5c is worth 5 1c coins.</p> <p>Complete pg. 115 in big book (Busy at Maths)</p> <p>https://my.cjfallon.ie/dashboard/resources</p>	<p>Busy at Maths pg. 30 and 31 (Home Links Book)</p> <p>Make sure child points to the objects when counting.</p>	<p>How can you make...?</p> <p>You could make this on a piece of paper or print it out and add cent sign to each of the numbers!</p> <p>Challenge the child to come up with different ways of making that amount e.g. take 3c (the child may pick out 3 1c coins but you could tell them that you can use a 2c and 1c to make 3c)</p> <p>https://www.twinkl.ie/resource/roi-n-5194-junior-infants-making-sets-of-1-to-5-activity-sheet</p>
