Online Learning for Ms. Curtin's Senior Infants

Week of January 25th-29th

Dear parents, please find below a description of the activities you may wish to use this week. There is no pressure to complete all of these, they are merely ideas. I will be adding all links mentioned to Seesaw Class app. Each child was given their own QR code for easy access to this app which was laminated and included in their homework folders. Please make sure you do not use the Seesaw Family app, the activities will not appear there, activities will only appear in Seesaw Class. If anyone has any problems logging in please let me know and I will email a new code to you.

I have included a mix of online videos, games, written work and books as well as play and art ideas **based on the theme of Australia**. You know your child best and what they can manage on a daily or weekly basis, I want to give plenty of options to help them engage and enjoy their learning as much as possible. I will post a schedule each day to seesaw class that you may wish to follow however there is no pressure to follow this at all! I have also archived last week's activities so any you did not get to complete will no longer appear in the feed.

Play is so important for young children and is how they learn best. Based on the theme of Australia I am including some play ideas you may wish to try out at home. I would love to see videos/photos of your play and creations!

Play Ideas:

- Playdough: Make an Australian animal- what about you try and make a koala, a kangaroo, a crocodile or a wombat!
- The Airport: pack a bag for a trip to Australia-what clothes will you need? It's a long flight, what will you wear, what will you do to keep yourself entertained, what snacks will you bring to eat? What accessories will you need eg) sunglasses, a sun hat, flip flops. Go through security, you'll need a passport, your ticket and your bag. Then take a seat on the airplane or change role and become a pilot, it's a long flight. What movie will you watch or will you take a nap?
- Junk Art: Using recyclable materials you have at home make an airplane, Australian animal or an Australian flag
- Baking: Pretend baking (if pretend follow the recipe but don't eat it, it's just for fun!):
 try out one of this popular Australian dessert called Lamingtons or why not really try
 and make Lamingtons, let me know how they turn out!

Oral Language: Weather: What is the weather like today? Is it rainy, sunny, cloudy, windy, foggy, hot, cold? What do you think the weather will be like tomorrow? What is the weather like in Australia today? What season is it? Is it hot or cold over there? What clothes would you wear if you were in Australia today?

Gaeilge: This week we will be learning about the weather in irish too, why not try and answer: Cén saghas lae atá ann inniu? Tá sé fliuch (wet), tirim (dry), gaofar (windy), fuar (cold), scamallach (cloudy). Bua na Cainte lessons will be on seesaw class.

Phonics: Ms. Dooley is posting phonics activities for her group, please only complete her activities, there is no need to do both. For the rest of the children, they should use their yellow copy to write the sound and draw some pictures of objects that have that sound in it eg) oi=coin, ue=glue and try to write the word to match the picture they draw. Letter formation: This week we will begin writing Capital Letters. We will start with I and T. I will post videos to seesaw about letter formation. I would recommend completing page 18 in the big All Write Now on Monday, and page 11 about I in small grey All Write Now book on Tuesday. Page 19 in Big All Write Now on Wednesday and page 12 about T in small grey All Write Now book on Thursday so the children get lots of practice forming them.
