Can you think of and list some words that have the 'ue' sound. Simple worksheets will be added to Seesaw.

Maths: We are finishing off the maths curriculum this week with capacity. This is another very practical area of maths and can be completed with a basin of water outside, at the sandbox, in the garden with compost or even during bathtime!!!

Children should be encouraged to fill vessels with water or sand or whatever is suitable for them and use the language of capacity – **full, empty, holds more, holds less, holds most, holds least**. They should be encouraged to **estimate and measure** how many cupfuls of liquid/sand it will take to fill different sized vessels.

You may choose to complete Busy at Maths Pages 115-117 but learning through play is far more valuable to the children.

Gaeilge: Lán agus folamh – full and empty – watch out here – 'folamh' sounds like 'full' but it actually means 'empty'.
