<p><u>Maths</u></p>		<p><u>Number 1-Revision</u></p> <p>Talk about the number 1. Where can you see the number 1 in your house? Can you find one object? Try it with the other numbers i.e. 2, 3, 4, 5. Ask child to draw, show them your fingers depending on what number you are on. Listen to and watch '5 Little Penguins'</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=72pmY6iUrM</p>	<p><u>Number formation</u></p> <p>Children should know how to form numbers 1, 2 and 3. Try to practice forming numbers through writing, making with playdoh, matchsticks or even using shaving foam on a flat surface. Complete pg. 10 in yellow Busy at Maths book. (Number 1) The rhyme for writing the number 1 is 'Number 1 is like a stick a short line that is very quick'. Encourage child to say it while writing.</p>	<p><u>Counting Objects</u></p> <p>Play 'Show me'.</p> <p>You will need 10 counters- sweets/pasta/crayons. Ask your child to show you an amount. E.g. Show me 5. Show me 7 etc. Make sure that child is touching each object with their finger as they are counting and pushing it towards you so they don't count it twice. Get child to ask adult to show them amounts. Make sure they check that you are right.</p>	<p><u>Number 2 – Revision</u></p> <p>Talk about the number 2. Where can you see the number 2 in your house? Can you find two objects? Discuss a pair – We wear a pair of socks/shoes/gloves etc. Ask child to draw a set of 2 things. Complete page in Busy at Maths. 11 – Encourage child to say rhyme when writing the Number 2 is 'Around the back on the railway track choo choo'.</p> <p>Send pictures of pg 10 & 11 in Busy at Maths to teacher on Seesaw</p>
