-Spellings: learn the following spellings and place words into sentences.

1. Look for different sized containers/bottles at home and order them from smallest to biggest (e.g. 100ml, 250ml, 500ml, etc.).
2. Find a measuring jug in your kitchen (make sure it has markings for measuring liquid, e.g. 100ml, 200ml).
3. Draw a picture of the measuring jug in your maths copy.
4. Discuss and write down the measurements on the jug in terms of fractions of 1 Litre in your maths copy (e.g 500ml= $\frac{1}{2}$, 250ml= $\frac{1}{4}$)
5. Children can make a collection of different containers/bottles that hold the same amount of liquid.
6. Find 2 litre bottle. Using a smaller 500ml drink bottle see how many times it takes to fill the 2 Litre bottle. Write the results in the copy
